COCKTAILS \$17.0

Sazerac

Created by a French chemist living in New Orleans during the 1830's but "Americanised" by replacing cognac with Rye whiskey due to lack of supply. The Sazerac is made with rye whiskey (or cognac), bitters and hint of absinth finished with a twist of orange.

Mint Julep

First made print in London in 1803 though it was most certainly served in the southern states of America in the 18th century. It has been the drink of the Kentucky Derby since 1938 where it is served to the winner in his trophy. The Mint Julep is made with bourbon whiskey, mint and sugar served over crushed ice.

Manhattan

The Classic New York Cocktail is said to date from 1874 and created by a bartender name 'Black' ten doors down from the Manhattan Lounge. The Manhattan is made traditionally with Canadian Rye or Bourbon Whiskey, Sweet Vermouth and bitters and finished with a twist of orange and a cherry.

Martini

Possibly the most famous and sophisticated cocktail ever mixed. Believed to have been created in New York during the early 1900's as a solution to the poor quality gin available at the time. The Martini is made your way with gin (or alternatively, Vodka) and vermouth and finished with olives or citrus zest.

Negroni

Developed sometime around 1919 at Café Casoni in Florence, Italy when asked to make something "a little stronger". The Negroni is made with Gin, Campari and Sweet Vermouth.

Old Fashioned

Created in the late 1800's in Louisville, Kentucky by a post war colonel and whiskey distiller. The Old Fashioned is a perfect blend of Bourbon Whiskey, Sugar and Bitters finished with a twist of orange.

Espresso Martini

This drink was created in the 1990's by London's cocktail guru Dick Bradsell in a bar called Pharmacy in London's Notting Hill, and was known as a Vodka Espresso. The Espresso Martini is made using Vodka, Coffee Liqueur, Liqor 43, Vanilla Sugar and a shot of freshly extracted Espresso

Hot Buttered Rum

After molasses began being imported to colonial America from Jamaica, and distilleries opened in New England in the 1650's, colonist began adding rum to hot beverages such as toddies and nogs, creating beverages such as the Hot Buttered Rum and Egnogs among others. The Hot Buttered Rum is made using Rum, Butter, Nutmeg, Cinnamon, Cloves and Vanilla then fused together with boiling water and brown sugar

Ramos Gin Fizz

Created in New Orleans during the late 1800's by Henry Charles Ramos. It is originally known as the New Orleans Fizz and was one of the city's most popular cocktails before prohibition. It takes twelve minutes to shake a Ramos Gin Fizz properly, so Ramos employed shaker boys to do the shaking for him. The Ramos Gin Fizz is made with Gin, Orange Blossom, Lemon and Lime Juice, Egg White, Sugar, Cream and Vanilla topped with soda.

Mojito

The Mojito is quite possibly the world's first cocktail. One story traces the origins of the popular cocktail back the 16th century, created to cover up the harsh taste of Tafia, a primitive form of Rum. The Mojito is made with White Rum, Lime, Mint and Sugar.

Golden Dawn

This Cocktail was named after the Hermetic Order of the Golden Dawn, which was a magical order of the late 19th and early 20th centuries practicing a form of spiritual development. The Golden Dawn is made with Calvados, Apricot Brandy, Gin and Orange Juice.

Whiskey Sour

This drink appeared alongside many of the true classics in Jerry Thomas' 1862 book, 'A Bartenders Guide'. The Whiskey Sour is made with Scotch Whiskey, Lemon Juice, Egg White and Sugar.

Hemingway Daiquiri

This is a variation of the classic daiquiri, created in honour of Ernest Hemmingway in 1921 in Havana, Cuba. The drink contains little sugar, instead using maraschino liqueur to sweeten the drink. The Hemmingway Daiquiri is made with White Rum, Maraschino Liqueur, Lime and Grapefruit Juice.

Mai Tai

Dated as early as the early 1930's during a time when Island themed restaurants known as Tiki Bars were becoming popular in the U.S. This drink was named in the U.S bartenders guide as one the defining drinks of the 20th Century and was prominently featured in the Elvis Presley film Blue Hawaii. Our Mai Tai is made with Aged Jamaican Rum, Lime Juice, Pineapple Juice, Orange juice and Orgeat.

Sidecar

Created in Paris during WW1 when requested by a Military officer, who was driven around in a motorcycle sidecar, to make a warming Aperitif containing brandy. The Sidecar is made using Brandy, Cointreau and Lemon Juice served Martini style in a sugar-rimmed glass.

Tom Collins

Invented in England by a bartender named John Collins. It's name coming from a combination of the bartender's name, Collins, and the gin used, Hayman's Old Tom. The Tom Collins is made with Gin, lemon juice and sugar and topped with a hint of soda water.

Caipirinha

This drink is made with Brazil's national spirit, Cachaça, a type of rum distilled from fermented sugar cane juice. Over 200 million litres of this spirit is consumed annually in Brazil. The Caipirinha is made with Cachaça, Lime and Sugar.

Pisco Sour

Pisco, a spirit derived from grapes, was made in both Chile and Peru during the 1500's after the production of wine was banned by colonial rule. The Pisco Sour, however, was created in Chile during the late 1800's. The Pisco Sour is made using Chilean Pisco, Lemon Juice, Egg White, Sugar and a hint of Bitters.

Margarita

A Mexican bartender created this drink for a woman named Marguerite in the 1930's and has since become a true classic. The Margarita is made using Tequila, Cointreau, Lime Juice and a hint of Sugar.

In 1993 an 8ha vineyard was planted totally dedicated to providing superior pinot noir and pinot gris with consistent quality. Although many of the vineyards are covered in snow in the winter, the long hot summers are balanced with cool night-time temperatures encouraging a slow ripening, perfect for developing intense fruit flavours, characteristic of the area. All grapes are hand harvested and low cropped, to ensure quality.

Wine maker Dean Shaw has an absolute passion for pinot noir with experience in Burgundy, Champagne, Alsace and South Africa as well as Central Otago. Using a natural approach to winemaking, Dean uses wild yeasts and enables the wine to reflect the character of the vineyard it comes from.
